## GALO TRUJILLO ENYHOF 2014



Galo Trujillo's passion for soccer began when he was very little, playing in the streets of his neighborhood in Ibarra, Ecuador. In Ecuador (as in most of Latin America), soccer is a way of life. A cultural norm. For Galo, what began, as favorite pastime would later become his life? A love of the sport pushed Galo to become a league founder, coach, referee, assessor and instructor of other referees.

Shortly after migrating to the United States in 1994 with the love of his life his wife Giovanna and his two children Galo Jr and Maria Cristina, Galo realized that Mount Kisco lacked an organized league that would allow him and an increasing number of Latin immigrants to fuel a passion for soccer. Against all odds, during a time of less tolerance for Hispanic members of the Mount Kisco community, he successfully helped found the Men's Soccer League in Mount Kisco and held the position as President for over 18 years. His mission statement was to provide an organized, competitive soccer league for adult, Hispanic males in the Mount Kisco area. The players were divided into twelve teams; it is not an exaggeration to say that the activities surrounding soccer are the week's highlight for many of these men.

As neighboring towns began forming leagues of their own, Galo understood that there would be a greater need for Spanish speaking referees. His friend and mentor, Mr. Jose Vargas (a former ENY SRA, assignor and official) encouraged him to become an official referee in order to meet this need. As a referee, Galo developed an appreciation for interacting with the players on a professional and educational level. He used this newfound passion to become an AYSO volunteer for 12 years, assistant coach, head coach and referee. As well as, certificated USSF referee (State 5 grade) assessor, instructor, NISOA soccer official, and NFHS official. Galo Trujillo has used soccer to create opportunities and provide services that allow countless members of the community to indulge in their passion for soccer inspire new generations and improve the quality of life for many of the communities' members.

## RAY WOLFE ENYHOF 2014



Ray began his involvement with soccer well over 40 years ago as a player with Kolping SC and BW Gottschee in the German American Soccer League.

As a young father, he went on to coach both of his sons who also in played for Gottschee.

In 1985, Ray became a referee and began a stellar career as a soccer official. He has officiated at every level, climbing the ranks through his excellence on the pitch, from youth to adult to professional and international matches. He officiated Ecuador vs. Honduras; Schalke (Germany) vs. Russia; Palermo vs. New York Select; the Armed Forces International Tournament in Florida and a women's match between Norway and China. In 1993, he was selected to officiate the World Universal Games in Niagara Falls and was so highly thought of that he officiated both the semi-final and the finals !

A member of NISOA, Ray rose quickly from JV and Varsity High School matches to NCAA college games. Spending many years as the center official in First Division matches

As a referee administrator, Ray has served as a long time Trustee for the Referee Association. He assumed his current position of State Youth Referee Administrator in 2008 and has been a key player in both the growth and development of our young referees.

## MILAGROS ARANA ENYSHOF 2014



March 1988 – Joined Nova SC in NYMWSL as a player (started as a sweeper, ended career as a GK)  
July 1988 – was voted in as NYMWSL secretary, held the position for 4 years  
July 1992 - was voted in as NYMWSL Vice President, held the position for 6 years  
July 1998 – was voted in as NYMWSL Public Relations officer, held the position for 2 years  
July 2000 – was voted in as NYMWSL President, still there

In between all that time:

Served as ENYSSA trustee for 1 year (not sure of year, mid to late '90's....I took Valerie Blanchenay's spot when she moved)

Served as ENYSSA recording secretary for 3 years? Mid to late 2000's

Managed the Nova SC from 1988-1996 (they later became NYAC). Made it to the State Cup final in 1996.

Managed/Coached Manhattan Kickers Women's Soccer Club from 1996 to present (started a second team

in 1999, still manage both teams). Also played until I retired in 2007. The 1<sup>st</sup> team won the State Cup in 2012.

Assisted Lyndelle and Nino for over a decade with the State Select team

Was on the NY Magic W-League Staff from 1997-2007, helping with game day operations, etc.

Was an assistant coach for a U-10 girls team in the Cosmopolitan Junior League 2005-2006

Organized and put together an over 30 team to enter the National Cup in 2007. The team became the first women's team ever in ENYSSA to win the National Cup (we did it before NYAC! Our game was earlier in the morning!

## BILL SMITH ENYSHOF 2014



Started his career in youth soccer 21 years ago coaching the Richmond town (Staten Island) Wildcats Girls U-6 team. The following year, he began coaching the girl's Rockets team for the same club, serving as their head coach for the next 6 years and capturing tournament championships along the way. In 1996, Bill became Director (ie: President) of the club and immediately increased membership by 71 %. He also assumed another coaching job for its' Boys U-6 team. In 1999 Bill took on the additional responsibility of training Richmond town's entire soccer program.

In 1997, Bill also began coaching U-8 Boys for Staten Island United, continuing as their coach for the next ten years. During this time, Bill received his USSF National "D" license and also became a certified referee. (In 2012 he added both a Referee Assignor and a CPR certification as well.) By 2009, he had gone on to coach the MetroStars/Red Bulls Academy team and Monsignor Farrell HS JV and Varsity Boys teams.

In 1995, Bill joined the Staten Island Youth Soccer League's Executive Board as Fourth Vice President, moving up to third and then second Vice President by 1998. In 2004, Bill was elected President of SIYSL's 6,000 players; a position he continues to hold today.

Under his leadership, SISYL has implemented, among other the following:

4. Staten Island Select Soccer program
5. Staten Island Youth Soccer Hall Of Fame

7. Staten Island Soccer Senior Day recognizing HS graduates from SISYL
8. Annual SISYL Holiday Gala and recognition for volunteers

The tragic events of Hurricane Sandy in 2012 had a profound effect on Staten Island and our members there. But it was in this time that Bill really shone! He became a tireless advocate on their behalf. He virtually emptied the SISYL treasury to insure that every child affected by this disaster received Christmas presents, soccer equipment, etc. He spent hundreds of hours lobbying local politicians and school officials to get equipment and replacement fields; adding two new field complexes so far; and yet never failed to fulfill his day-to-day responsibilities to SISYL and ENYSSA. His leadership in this regard was truly outstanding!

In 2010, Bill was elected to the Eastern New York Executive Board as Fourth Vice President and is still a member, currently serving as the Third Vice President, presently serving on numerous committees.

## JOHN STEIGERWALD 2014



John was born 1942, half a block away from the old Eintracht Oval in Astoria on 20th Ave and 36th Street. When John was 6 years old (1948) and a rambunctious kid, he joined Eintracht to play soccer. He played there until 1960 when he enlisted in the navy for 4 years (1960-64). While in there he played for the ship in many friendly games across continents. He served on the USS Enterprise, where he picked up his habit of drinking black coffee. When he came out (1964), he joined Malta for 2 years (1964-66) and then played for Brooklyn Celtic (1966-68), at that point, he played for Blue Star in the top division of the GASL, in 1970 he temporarily retired Eintracht in 1972 called John to play in the Over 30 division as a goalie, he played there until injuries forced him to retire in 1988. John became the vice president for Eintracht in 1975, which meant he ran all social affairs until 2014 John coached the Eintracht Over 30 team 1992 to 2009. Since 1999, he became

arbiter for the CSL, which he still is today, he also became the CSL delegate to the state in 1999, again, a job he still holds until today. 2001, he became a trustee of the ENYSASA.

John has spent his time in the service of soccer, his greatest contribution has been, his reliability and steadfastness. If you ever want to depend on somebody, he is the man. The NY HOF can be certain to add a "good" man to its ranks, we sincerely hope, he will be seen as a valuable addition.
